Setting the Agenda

The Parliamentarian and/or the Congress Coordinator will lead the chamber in setting its agenda during Preliminary Business. **Once finalized, the agenda MAY NOT be reordered.** However, the chamber may use appropriate procedure to delay consideration of items, e.g., by postponing the Session 1 PO's B/R until Session 2.

Guidelines

1. Items whose named author is in the chamber should be scheduled ahead of other B/R.
These authors are entitled to an opportunity to present their B/R.
2. If the author is not present, any legislator from the submitting school **may** take the author's place if the student does not have another B/R. This privilege must be claimed when the agenda is set.
3. Every school is entitled to present one B/R before any school presents a second B/R.
4. Legislation with no same-school sponsor, including Super Congress items, should be scheduled after the sponsored items. Sponsorship speeches for these items will be awarded according to the usual rules of priority as the items come to the floor for debate.
5. If the chamber cannot decide on an order, the impasse will be broken by random draw.
