**Events:** All NCFL Events. No double entries. No more than SIX entries per event.

Cost: \$25.00 per competitor including host/lunch fee PLUS an additional \$10.00 lunch fee for each judge including training judges. Fees can be paid via Pay Pal on the league website, checks (made out to FGCCFL) for the full amount, or cash. All fees must be paid in full by the fourth round of the tournament. Late payments are no longer accepted.

Food: Closed campus (FGCCFL rule). No one may leave campus for lunch and no one may have lunch delivered during tournaments. Lunches are automatically ordered for students, judges, judge training participants, and 10/14 novice observers as part of registration; ONE complimentary lunch will be provided to each school for the head coach. Our host has ordered a variety of sub sandwiches from Publix for lunch. Coaches must order (designate) all participants' lunches in www.tabroom.com's LUNCH tab. Sub choices will include: ham, turkey, and veggie.

Judging requirements: One (1) judge for every five IE and Congress entries combined; schools with Congress entries must designate at least one "Congress Preferred" judge. One (1) judge for every two LD entries. One (1) judge for every two PFD team entries. LD and PFD judges will be placed in one debate pool and must be cross-trained. One (1) judge for each TD team entry. COACHES: Do not count yourself in your judge quota as we must be able to use you where needed! All coaches should be prepared to serve as Parliamentarian, supervise Extemp Prep, or judge if needed in Round 4. Judges should be cross-trained. Remember to list conflicts (by STUDENT FULL NAME) in the "Judge Notes" space on Tabroom.

**Balloting:** All debate events at this tournament will use Tabroom for electronic ballots. Judges must have a linked Tabroom account and provide a suitable connected device (laptop or tablet preferred). Judges of individual events and Congress will utilize paper ballots, which will be available in debate events, in the event of an equipment outage.

**New Judge Training:** The FGCCFL will conduct new judge training during the morning rounds and assign the "judges-in-training" to shadow other registered judges in the afternoon rounds. Coaches will register their trainees in tabroom, and these participants will pay a \$10 host/lunch fee.

**Observations:** Novice students will have the opportunity to observe rounds to learn about different events and to see what happens at a forensics tournament. Observers will pay a \$10 host/lunch fee. They will be assigned to watch four rounds in different events on a space-available basis; they are expected to adhere to the Code of Conduct and may not flow or take notes during rounds.

# **REGISTRATION FOR THE TOURNAMENT:**

Registration will not be accepted once registration is closed or by any other means than Tabroom unless directed to do so. Pay attention to your school registration for students, judges in correct pools, and total lunch orders. Tabroom registration will open at 7 AM on Saturday, September 23, and closes at 9 PM on the Thursday prior to the tournament week. Please have registration confirmed before registering the team on Tabroom. The registration deadline for this tournament is 5 October 2023.

Coaches must have set up team and judge rosters on Tabroom prior to attempting to register. All students and judges must set up their own individual Tabroom accounts.

**TITLE REQUIREMENT FOR IE:** Selection titles, authors, and publication information (where applicable) **must** be specified for all entries in OO, Dec, DP, OI, and Duo. For OI, please list the two program titles (separated by a slash) in the Title field, then list all included works in the Bibliography field.

Please note: The Executive Committee will levy additional tournament fees of \$25.00 for any dropped entry on the tournament day including drops after start of first round, and for each registered, but missing judge. All changes made after the close of registration, but before tournament day must be reported to Jym Froelich at < <u>James.Froelich@sarasotacountyschools.net</u>> and Josh Schneider at < <u>joshschneider@me.com</u>>. Schools will forfeit registration fees for all drops made after the close of online registration on the Thursday before tournament week.

## **Tournament Day Registration:** 7:15 - 7:45

Only the team Head Coach or Assistant Coach should proceed through the registration line. Coaches should have invoice and registration forms printed from Tabroom and correct fees in check/large bills or paid online via the website. Head Coaches or Assistant Coaches should register in the Media Center. Students will report to the Cafeteria. Judges will report to the Media Center. Please bring a copy of registration from Tabroom, check made out to FGCCFL or cash, or Pay Pal receipt from the league website.

Schools MUST be registered no later than 7:45 AM. Announcements for students and judges will begin at 8:00 AM. Rounds should begin by 8:30 AM.

# **CONGRESS RULES:**

Every school entering Student Congress **MUST** provide at least one (1) piece of satisfactory legislation. Schools may submit up to six (6) items, but no student may sponsor more than one (1) item. Congress entries will be **waitlisted** until an item of legislation has been submitted and approved.

All legislation must be written using the templates on the FGCCFL website and uploaded to Tabroom by the registration deadline (9:00 PM on the **Thursday prior to tournament week**). Late, frivolous, stale, or unsatisfactory legislation will not be considered. The legislative docket and chamber assignments will be published on Friday evening.

Coaches may email legislation to Josh Schneider < <u>joshschneider@me.com</u>> for review; allow 48 hours for a response. This is NOT a substitute for uploading the legislation to Tabroom.
